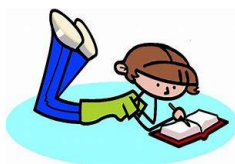

## A message from the Head Teacher

Hello All,

I am really surprised to note that I have been in post here for nearly a year now and it has been wonderful. Thank you all. As with all things the more established you become the more able you are to deal with increasingly challenging things.

Welton CE is a gorgeous village school, it has a deep-seated set of values rooted in Christian teaching, which regardless of personal faith are applied and adhered to. It has come to my attention that some pupils do not feel as safe as they should in school. I am also informed that the school had some historic issues with bullying that some parents felt were unresolved.

On this very public forum I can safely say that any bullying incidents will be dealt with consistently, constructively and fairly.

Bullying is where one or more people physically, emotionally or psychologically hurt or cause harm to a person who is in a weaker position than him/her/them, and so is less able to defend himself/herself. In addition, bullying usually happens over a period of time consisting of different incidents.

Every member of the school community is expected to act in principled, caring and reflective ways. If this does not happen, the matter will be taken seriously, and we will work with all parties to ensure pupils feel safe and behaviours are moderated.

I cannot say with honesty that incidents won't happen. What I can say is that, when we are aware, we will deal with them.

All of us have a shared and common goal of happy, well-rounded children who are able to be: resilient with life's challenges; engaged with the learning around them; motivated to try a hard as possible; beautiful inside to show kindness and empathy to all they meet. Our core values of aspiration, respect, ambition, compassion, courage and integrity are at the heart of all we do.
